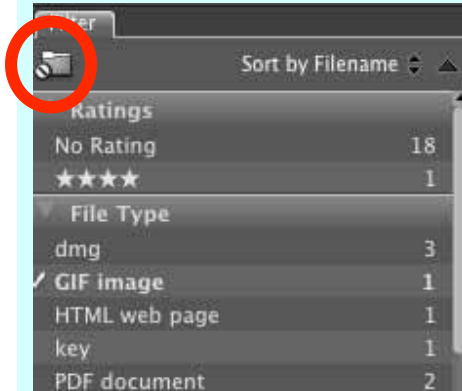

Filter Panel



Flat View Icon

- Allows all folders to open in Preview (red circle)

Filtering

- Click on item type to be viewed (i.e. GIF image, , jpg, date created, etc)

Preview Panel



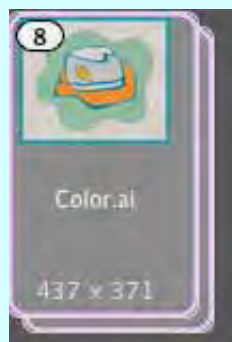
Multiple Selection

- Shift or Command click on multiple items in Content panel to display in Preview

Loupe

- Click on image in Content panel to show in preview
- Click now on area to be zoomed in Preview Panel
- Use + or – to change scale





Stack Option: groups items together without having to make separate folders



- Select multiple items
- Stacks Menu>Group as Stack
- Click on Number to display all members

<p>New & Enhanced Tools</p>	<p>Quick Select Tool</p> 	<p>Cool new tool acts like magic wand with a brain. Will select like color based on crosshair in center of brush</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select Quick Select Tool • Click and drag over object to be selected • Hold down Option Key to remove from selection (or choose subtract button on Option Bar) • [] keys will increase or decrease brush size
	<p>Refine Edge</p> 	<p>Good for all selections (made with or without Quick Select Tool)</p> <p>Make selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click Refine Edge on Option Bar • Adjust Feather, Contrast and others to better select your image • Choose the mask type at bottom to determine if selection is acceptable <p>(cannot add or subtract from selection within dialog)</p>
	<p>Clone Tool</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sample Option: Current layer and below (new) • Turn off Sampling of Adjustment Layers



<p>New Features</p>	<p>Smart Filters (filters on layers, yea!)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Duplicate Layer (always smart!) • Filter Menu>Convert for Smart Filters • Add filter or filters as desired (either by filter gallery or filter menu) • Dbl-clk name of filter to edit (red circle)  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dbl-clk icon to edit opacity and blending mode of filter (blue circle)
	<p>Auto Align Layers</p>	<p>Allows for perfect alignment of images to make editing easier</p> <p>Make sure two similar images are in same document on separate layers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select layers • Edit Menu> Auto Align Layers>Auto • Select topmost layer to be edited • Turn on layer mask (protects images)  • Target Layer Mask • Use paint brush to paint away to underlying layer

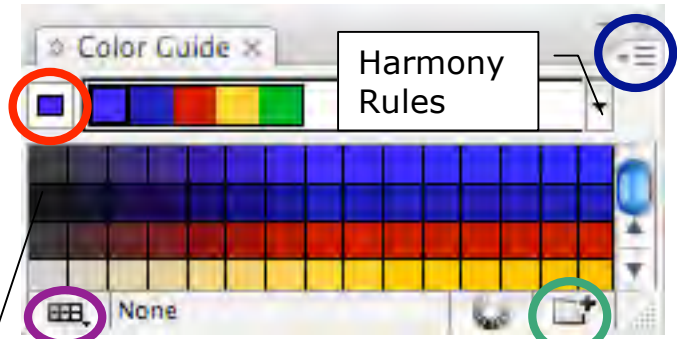

New Features

Color Guide

This feature makes it easy to choose complimentary colors for your design



Variation Grid

Create variations of color and selected objects' color properties by using harmony sets and other options. Colors are selected like swatches and applied by varying scales.

- Select a color from either:
 - color panel
 - swatch panel
 - selecting artwork
- Click Set Base Color button (red circled)
- Pick a Harmony Rule from pop-up for color spectrum choices

The Variation Grid will provide a plethora of color choices based on the Set Base Color, Rules and Shades chosen.

- Pick Variations from Panel Menu (blue circled): Tints & Shades, Warms & Cools or Vivid & Muted
- Apply color to object by dragging and dropping
- Add new color mix to Swatches by hitting Color Group Button at bottom (green circled)
- Limit colors to a specific library (i.e. Pantone) by choosing the library button at bottom (purple circled). Choose Color Books to access the Pantone library

New Features

Live Color

Used to create and/or edit color groups as well as reassign or reduce colors in artwork.

- (a) create/edit color group
- (b) assign colors in Assign tab (harmonies)
- (c) select color group to apply (also found within Swatch panel)

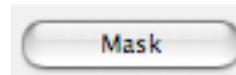
(Accessed either through Color Guide panel, Swatch panel or Edit Menu>Edit Colors>Recolor Artwork...)


Pick either Assign or Edit to work in

- In Edit, select link button to lock color maps together to be moved
- Click on any tool (line with circle) and change by moving or with sliders below

Masking w/Placed Images

Create Clipping Mask with adjustable frame.



- File Menu>Place
- Select Item to be placed choose Link or Embed
- Click on Mask Button in Control Panel
- Redefine Mask by selecting corner with Selection Tool and scale Mask
- Reshape Mask with Direct Selection Tool
-  Toggle between icons for editing Clipping Path or Contents.

New Tool

Crop Tool



Sets the print area. Multiple crop marks are possible but only one can be used at a time.

(see more description in New Features below)

- Select Crop tool>click and drag to define area.
- Hit Return to access options.
- Hold Down Opt key to create and select one of multiple cropped area

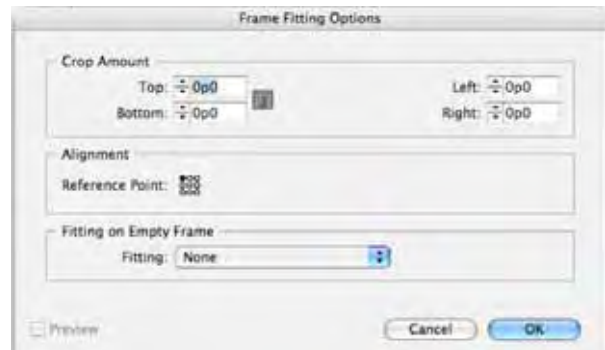


InDesign

New Feature

Frame Fitting Options

To be used for specific placing options for graphics within a bounding box.



(can be included with an object style)

- Select object go to Object Menu>Fitting>Fitting Options...

Multi-place images, text & InDesign files

Place multiple images text and *InDesign documents at one time with different options per item.

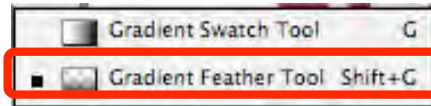


- Placing Item shows a thumbnail and item count for placing

*placing InDesign documents should be done with care. In certain situations printing issues have arisen. test test test

New Tool

Gradient Feather Tool



Underlying the Gradient Swatch tool use to add gradient transparency to objects

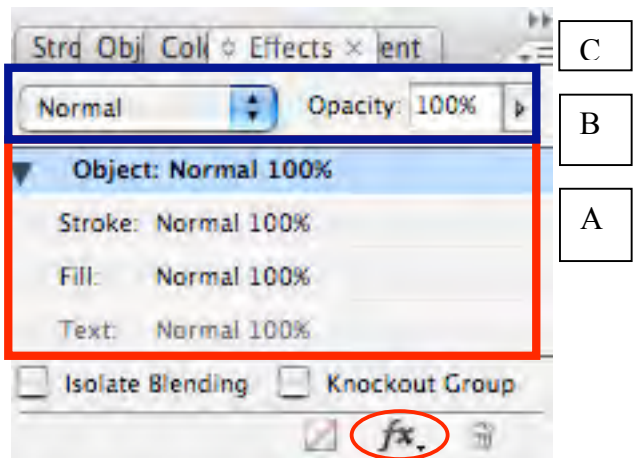
- Select object
- Select Gradient Feather Tool
- Click and drag over object (double-click tool to access options)

New Palette/Panel

Effects

Replaces Transparency with Effects panel. More effects available and applicable to varies levels: fill, text, object.

Window Menu:Effect Panel



- Select item (text, rule or picture frame)
- Choose level to apply: Object, Stroke, Fill, Text (A)
- Change Opacity, Blending Mode) (B)
- Choose Panel Menu for more options (C)
- FX:Effects (ex) Dropshadow, Inner Shadow etc.
